

WARNING

**The Louisiana Department of Health and Hospitals
has added the following chemicals to the
Controlled Dangerous Substance Act as Schedule I drugs:
3,4-Methylenedioxymethcathinone (Methylone);
3,4-Methylenedioxypropylone (MDPV);
4-Methylmethcathinone (Mephedrone); 4-Methoxymethcathinone;
4-Fluoromethcathinone; and 3-Fluoromethcathinone.**

It is now illegal to possess, distribute or manufacture products with these chemicals. Violators could face up to 30 years imprisonment.

These chemicals are commonly found in products being marketed as “bath salts” and “plant food” by the brand names Ivory Wave, Ocean, Charge +, White Lightning, Scarface, Hurricane Charlie, Red Dove, Cloud-9 and White Dove.

Individuals and retailers with these products should contact their local law enforcement to find out how to safely dispose of these drugs.
