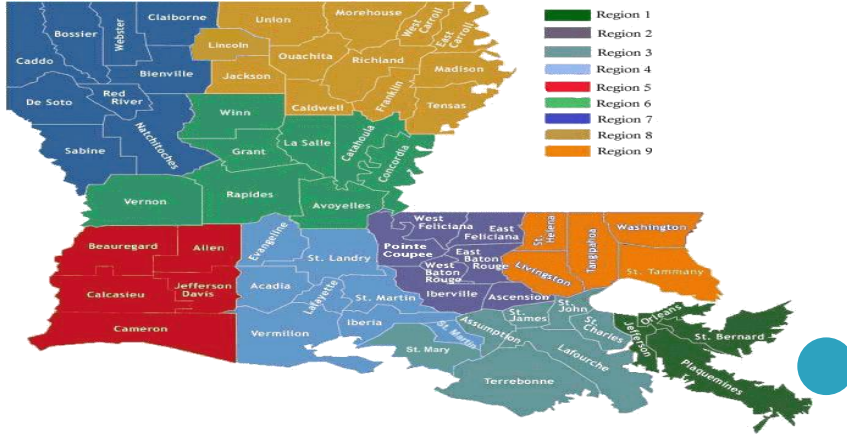

## PROVIDER LOCATOR

- Parish search is being postponed. Providers need to be able to indicate what parishes they serve in the system for this to be useful
- Become familiar with how services are laid out
- Serves as Freedom of Choice List (FoC)
- Not possible to do combination searches at this time
- Must print a new FoC every time, expect frequent additions, some deletions



## JOB AIDS

- Risk Assessment Screening Tool
- Change in Status Tool

### Purposes

- Use for planning
- Forms are not mandatory, but do lead the SC through care planning process
- Mandatory that process be used during planning
- May be used for initial, interim and annual planning



## CCW REFERRAL FORM - MANDATORY

- Natural progression from risk assessment & significant change processes
- For use between SC and Home Health Agency (HHA), therapist, nurse and/or or for Environmental Accessibility Adaptation (EAA) assessment referral
- Facilitates communication to and from SC and Provider
- Designed to prompt and encourage assessment referrals
- Will assist SC in pricing out services for Plan of Care

## REFERRAL FORM – PAGE 1

- Participant chooses provider from Freedom of Choice List
- Page 1 – Completed by SC to identify issue(s) and make referral for assessment to specific agency/professional

## REFERRAL FORM – PAGE 2

- Page 2 & 3 – SC indicates return date for inclusion of treatment in PoC
- Remainder completed by provider to identify services currently provided by assessor for participant and identification of payer source
- Speaks to third party liability issue and ensuring that services are not duplicated
- Not necessary for EAA since assessor is not provider of participant services

## REFERRAL FORM

- Page 3 - Used by provider to lay out the treatment plan for PoC and budget development
- Based on number of visits or pre-determined rates
- Home Health Agency may refer for therapy visits, PAS, Activity Sensor Monitoring, and EAA assessment (if absolutely necessary) using form

## ENVIRONMENTAL ACCESSIBILITY ADAPTATIONS ASSESSMENT REFERRALS

- OAAS developing job aid to help SC determine type of assessment needed – therapy or EAA
- Goal of aid is to determine the appropriate assessment
- Easy to use tool that helps avoid unnecessary costly EAA assessments
- In rare cases, therapy and EAA assessment will be used. Not expected to occur often.
