

## **Local Reporting: Louisiana Part C Annual Performance Report 2012-13**

*In accordance with Part C of the Individuals with Disabilities Education Improvement Act (IDEA), each state must have in place a State Performance Plan (SPP) to evaluate the state's efforts to meet the requirements and purposes of the implementation of IDEA and report annually on its performance. Louisiana's statewide performance on the 14 indicators which are used to measure performance is available on the EarlySteps website at [www.earlysteps.dhh.louisiana.gov](http://www.earlysteps.dhh.louisiana.gov). In addition, The U.S. Department of Education, Office of Special Education Programs requires that all States report annually to the public on the performance of its local early intervention programs. Louisiana defines "local program" as each of the 9 or 10 regional programs of the state's DHH regions. In most cases, reporting periods 2005-2013 are shown together for comparison across fiscal years where possible. The results are presented by the whole state as well as by region.*

### **Monitoring Priority: Indicator 1--Early Intervention Services Received in a Timely Manner**

This indicator is calculated as the percentage of infants and toddlers with IFSP's who receive the early intervention services on their IFSP's in a timely manner. *Timely* is defined as within 30 days of parent consent for services on the IFSP. Data is collected in the first quarter of each fiscal year. IFSPs for each family support coordination from all regions of the State were reviewed.

**Discussion:**

The table above shows the birth to age one year child count per region. The row labeled "Expected" gives the expected number of children to be identified based on the population of children ages birth to one year in that region(updated with 2007 birth data). The rows labeled "Actual" indicate the actual number of the birth to one population found eligible in the given year. For example, in 2005, Region 3 identified 196 children ages birth to one year in EarlySteps, 83 were expected. The decrease in the numbers of children identified from 2005 to 2006 is the result of the "narrow" or more restrictive eligibility criteria used in 2006 as well as the impacts of Hurricanes Katrina and Rita in 2005. The eligibility criteria was revised (broader criteria) in July, 2007 and in May, 2010 (more narrow) and the numbers of children found eligible has changed with the eligibility criteria.

**Monitoring Priority: Indicator 6—Number of infants ages birth to three years with IFSP’s in EarlySteps**

This indicator is calculated as the percentage of infants and toddlers birth to 3 with IFSP’s compared to:

- A. Other states with similar eligibility definitions, and
- B. National Data.

**Discussion:**

The table above shows the actual numbers identified for each region in the rows indicated by the year. The row labeled with "expected" indicates the target number for each region based on the number of children ages birth to 3 years of age in each region. The rows labeled "Actual" give the actual number of children served ages birth to 3 years in the region. The decrease in numbers of children served in 2006 as compared to 2005 is the result of the change to a more restrictive eligibility criteria and the impact of Hurricanes Katrina and Rita. In July, 2007 and May, 2010 the eligibility criteria changed and the numbers of eligible children birth to three years have changed following the criteria revisions.

**Monitoring Priority: Indicator 7—Evaluation and assessment and IFSP developed within the 45-day timeline**

This indicator is calculated as the percentage of eligible infants and toddlers with IFSP's for whom an evaluation and assessment and an initial IFSP meeting were conducted within the required 45-day timeline. The State Actual amounts include all delayed IFSPs, including those delayed due to family reasons.

This indicator is calculated as the percentage of all children exiting Part C who receive timely transition planning to support the child’s transition to preschool and other appropriate community services by their third birthday including:

- A. IFSP’s with transition steps and services;
- B. Notification sent to LEA if child is potentially eligible for Part B services—this target is 100%
- C. Transition conference, if child is potentially eligible for Part B.

Data for A. and C. was collected through of monitoring of IFSP’s B. Is collected through the data system.

Louisiana achieved 100% for this indicator. This is accomplished through a report sent by the EarlySteps State office to the Louisiana Department of Education monthly. The report provides notice of the children in Part C that are potentially eligible for Part B services from all areas of the state. The report is then sent to the school systems by the Department of Education.
