

Residential Options Waiver (ROW)

Procedure to determine the individualized budget

An Inventory for Client and Agency Planning (ICAP) is completed initially and as needed; and is requested prior to the development of a ROW plan of care. The ICAP assessment instrument provides information used to identify support needs in addition to being the primary mechanism for establishing an individual's budget. The correlation between the overall ICAP score and the corresponding ICAP Service Level, ROW Acuity Level and ROW Individual Budget limits are as follows;

*Note: The assessed I-CAP Level, corresponding ROW Acuity and ROW Budget limit must be entered by SC to POC on pg. 1 and confirmed by Med Cert on budget approval page.

Inventory for Client and Agency Planning (I-CAP) – A standardized tool used to assess an individual's skills and behaviors, requiring support to allow people to live as independently as possible.

ICAP Service Score – The overall ICAP score that indicate the level of service intensity required by an individual, considering both adaptive and maladaptive behavior.

ICAP Service Level ranges - from 1 to 9 and indicates the service need intensity. The lower the score/level the greater the individual need.

ICAP Support Level – the overall level of support, supervision or training a person may require is determined by their ICAP service level and corresponding support level. If a person's support needs change, the ICAP tool is re-administered.

ROW Acuity Level – the rating guidance designed for allocating supports for individuals with similar current and potential support/service needs.

ROW Individual Budget Limit- The overall budget cap for each person in the Residential Options Waiver (ROW) is established based on each individual's overall Inventory for Client and Agency Planning (ICAP) score.
