Nurse-midwife services

Descriptions of Services as Provided are Listed Below:

1. Certified nurse-midwives are defined as registered professional nurses who are currently licensed in Louisiana and are legally authorized to practice midwifery.
2. Certified nurse-midwives must always work as members of physician-directed health care teams.
3. A nurse-midwife must enroll as a provider and obtain an individual Medicaid provider number.
4. Service coverage shall be determined by individual licensure, scope of practice, and the terms of the physician collaborative agreement.
5. The collaborating physician must be a Medicaid enrolled provider.
6. Collaborative agreements must be available for review upon request by authorized representatives of the Medicaid Program.
