Sanitarian Services has requested a letter of intent/application/enforcement as it applies to Title 51, Public Health, Sanitary Code, Part XIV, 407.2 Table 407, 407.2.2., Retail Store section.

This section of the Code requires more lavatories than water closets in the retail stores and has been the reason for many waiver requests in the past. As of this date, all waiver requests to lower the number of required lavatories to equal the number of required water closets have been granted.

I am hereby issuing this letter of intent. This letter of intent is applicable only to the Retail Store section of Table 407.2.2 only. Rulemaking on this issue will be initiated in the future.
