




Neighborhood Place Planning Map:



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


Neighborhood Place Planning Map:

 Selected Area for Livingston Parish (State Fiscal Year 2007)*





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
Neighborhood Place Planning Map:

*2007 Population estimates reference the ESRI 2007 data update, which is based on disaster agency reports, news reports, field work, revised models and other sources following the 2005 hurricanes (ESRI Gulf Coast Updates Methodology: 2006/2011, ESRI White Paper, August 2006). 2007 population estimates have been mapped by Zip Code and do not represent a statistical analysis of the data. 2007 overall parish and city population estimates from City-Data.com.

A note on Zip Codes: Zip Code Areas, when mapped, are not created or maintained by the U.S. Postal Service, but have been developed by mapping software or other data compilation companies to assist in the geographic display of data. Zip Code Areas (or "Zip-5") are based on street addresses and will therefore show some differences when compared with other datasets, such as Zip Code Tabulation Areas (ZCTAs) which are used by the US Census Bureau. A Zip Code that is contained in multiple parishes is assigned to the parish where the majority of the population is located, and will be only used in parish-wide calculations for the parish to which it has been assigned.

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


Nighborhood Place Planning Map: Population Shift from 2000 to 2007 by Census Tract for Livingston Parish*
