






Region 6 Meeting 1 Attendance, by Parish

SWOT Emerging Themes

Priority 1: Behavioral Health, Mental Health, Addictive Disorders

S: Growth in partnerships & collaborations to address BH at different levels, and rural access to BH services is good

W: Care coordination is a challenge, there is a need for prevention, education & awareness efforts.

O: The ACA is an opportunity, but is limited by unemployment. Expansion of services to rural populations (telehealth, ACA, coverage expansion) could improve rural access.

T: Cost of care and services & unemployment are major impediments for providers & patients. Access to care is a major issue (major barriers include: insurance, transportation, provider training & availability).



SWOT Emerging Themes

Priority 2: Healthcare & Insurance

S: Good rural HC access (which telehealth could improve further). Wellness & prevention programs do exist (both work & insurance based).

W: Lack of coordination & connectivity between providers, and patient care coordination is a challenge.


O: ACA is an opportunity, but barriers to care exist (coverage, system complexity).

T: Cost of care and services are major impediment for providers & patients

SWOT Emerging Themes


Priority 3: Unemployment & Economic Development

- S:** Opportunities (new industries) and resources exist, both for education & employment.
- W:** Lack of coordination between education system & potential employers/businesses. Education system needs to better prepare students for the job market in their community.
- O:** Many different efforts (public and private) at the community and state level to promote employment and business growth; technical and 4 year colleges are good collaborators in promoting employment & skills building.
- T:** Poor physical and mental health as well as barriers to insurance coverage are threats to employment & economic stability & prosperity.
